- JUNE 10 – COFFEE WITH A COP

The next "Coffee with a Cop" will be held at East Bay Coffee Company located at 2529 San Pablo Avenue on Wednesday, June 10, at 8:00 AM. The Pinole Police Department has initiated this program to provide an opportunity for the community to interact and meet the police officers who are working in their area. This is a monthly program that rotates each month to various locations throughout the city.

- JUNE 13 – FIFTH ANNUAL PINOLE COMMUNITY SERVICE DAY

- **JUNE 14 - BIKE THE BRIDGES FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS**

Once again, the Pinole Police Department employees will be partnering with the Hercules Police Department with raising awareness and support for the Special Olympics in the 6th Annual Bike the Bridges ride on Sunday June 14th. The cyclists will be riding 25, 30, 62 or 104 miles while enjoying some of the most beautiful views of the rolling hills in the Bay Area and of course the Carquinez and Benicia bridges.



In addition to the riders, several PD employees will be volunteering to support over 500 riders at the rest stops as well as driving support and gear (SAG) vehicles along the route to help and encourage the riders.

At the end of the ride, the cyclists and volunteers will be treated to an all-you-can eat BBQ and enjoy the craft beer festival.

- **JUNE 16 - CITY COUNCIL CONTINUES DISCUSSION OF PROPOSED FY 2015-16 ANNUAL BUDGET**

The City Council began their discussions on the Proposed FY 2015-16 Annual Budget at the June 2 City Council meeting. The next discussion of the budget will be at the regular June 16 City Council meeting. The discussion will cover the General Fund, Development Services Funds, Measures S 2006 and S 2014, the Wastewater Fund as well as the Proposed Five Year Capital Improvement Program. The public is encouraged to attend and provide input to the City Council.

- **JULY 12 – REFUSE TO BE A VICTIM CLASS TO BE HELD**

A class entitled, "Refuse to be a Victim" will be held in the Alex Cark Room on Sunday, July 12 from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM. The focus of the class is crime prevention and personal safety. The instructor will share topics such as:

NEW THIS WEEK...

- UPDATE ON CONVERSION PROCESS FOR PINOLE VALLEY PARK

The final report (Archeological) has been completed and submitted to the State Department of Parks to review along with the Conversion application. Earlier this year, the City purchased three parcels which will be utilized as the “property in lieu” to replace the property utilized for the replacement of Fire Station 74 property.

It is estimated that the State will take up to 60 days to review the application and all documents before we receive news as to whether the process is complete or additional information is required. To date, a total of \$291,000 has been spent on the conversion which does not include staff time.

- SKATE PARK CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The preconstruction meeting for the Pinole Skate Park was held on May 30, 2015. City staff met at the site with the contractor, MG Creations from Santa Cruz California, as well as our construction management and inspection team. The contractor will be mobilizing equipment and begin construction the week of June 15, 2015.

- STATE CERTIFIES CITY’S ADOPTED GENERAL PLAN HOUSING ELEMENT

The City Council adopted the 2015-2023 Housing Element Update to the General Plan on May 19. The Housing Element includes extensive housing information to better understand existing housing needs as well as policies and actions to help address these housing needs over time. Once adopted by the City, the document is required to be reviewed by the State Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) for consistency with State law. The City learned on May 29th that HCD has completed its review and certified that the City’s Housing Element meets State legal requirements.
