This internship with the Wastewater Treatment Plant is part-time, hourly, and non-benefitted. Assignments will include assisting in the operation, maintenance, and monitoring of the City's wastewater treatment facility.

The purpose of this position is to provide an opportunity for a high school graduate interested in the wastewater profession and interested in obtaining his/her Operator In Training (OIT) certificate to work side-by-side with plant personnel to acquire job skills and gain an understanding of plant processes, particularly maintenance, laboratory and plant operations.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS/EDUCATION

- High school graduate or equivalent.
- 18+ years of age.
- Residents of Hercules and Pinole are encouraged to apply

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Must possess and maintain a valid California Class C driver's license and a satisfactory driving record.

SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants must submit an original City of Pinole Employment Application to the Human Resources Department (by mail or delivery to Pinole City Hall). Applications will be screened for qualifications and the most qualified applicants will be invited for an interview. Those whose education, experience, and skills are determined to most closely match the requirements of this position and the department will be given a contingent offer of employment. Appointment will follow successful completion of pre-employment services (physical exam, drug screen, and background check). This is a part-time position and employment may terminate at any time with or without cause.
