Crime Prevention Tips

Safety Tips for the New Year:


1. If possible, don't jog, walk alone, especially at night and in less-populated areas.
2. Properly lock your home including closing your garage door even when you are at home.
3. Take the time to record the serial numbers of all your valuables. You may also want to consider marking certain items with your state driver's license number.
4. Please be sure to listen to that "little voice" inside of all of us. Be aware of your surroundings and look for any suspicious persons and activities.
5. Don't carry around large amounts of cash or wear valuables. If you need to use an ATM, go to a busy, well-lit location and only withdraw the amount of cash you really need.
6. Park your vehicle in well-lit, populated areas. Don't leave your key in the ignition and properly secure your vehicle (i.e. close your windows and lock the doors) when you park. **Also, don't leave any valuables in plain sight.**
7. Get to know your neighbors. Setting-up neighborhood watch programs and working together with your community and neighbors is the best way to spread safety awareness.
8. Consider carrying a cell phone especially if you are going somewhere alone. You may also consider telling a family member or a close friend of your travel plans in case of an emergency.
9. Consider installing a high-quality security system both in your home and vehicle.


Beat Map




There were no commercial burglaries reported this week.
